Vicki also has experience with mediation and dispute resolution through WIPO.

In addition to her litigation practice, Vicki also counsels clients in protecting trademark rights, including managing trademark opposition and cancellation proceedings globally. Vicki has also prosecuted utility patent applications in the mechanical arts and other fields, and has experience in transactional matters, such as preparing opinions and agreements involving various aspects of intellectual property.

Prior to becoming an attorney, Vicki worked in the plumbing division of Kohler Co. focusing on current and new product development of toilets, urinals, and other bathroom fixtures.
